Founded in the 7th century, Bath Abbey has not only a rich history spanning over hundreds of years, it can also seat up to 1,200 persons within its grand interiors. The former Benedictine monastery and current Parish church is a medieval masterpiece featuring mesmerizing stained-glass windows, the Heritage Vaults Museum, a 49 meters high two-stage central tower and breathtaking exteriors.
